### **SALES REPORT (JUNE 2019)**

The June industry is at 27,520 units.
The June 2019 volume is up 0.1% versus May 2019 and up 19% versus June 2018.

## 1) June Total Industry results in details:

- Total industry is at 27,520 units of which 20,287 units were Passenger Cars; 6,649 units were Commercial Vehicles and 584 units were Special-Purpose Vehicles.
- Passenger Cars were up 3% versus last month; Commercial Vehicles were down 9% and Special-Purpose Vehicles were up 14%
- CKD volume was 16,162 units, up 6% versus last month and CBU was 11,358 units, down 7% versus last month.




# 2) Year-to-Month June Total Industry results in details:
